



Masonboro Forest HOA Pool Policies and Rules

ALL residents and guests must show pool monitors your yellow pool pass. They will check you in by number and ask for your address. Residents have requested that this rule be strictly enforced to ensure that only residents and invited guests are permitted in the pool area. The pool monitors have been instructed that there are **NO** exceptions to this rule. So please parents, if not accompanying your children to the pool, send them with the yellow pass. Your cooperation concerning this rule is greatly appreciated.

No Lifeguard on duty. Pool monitors are not lifeguards. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. Owners and management are not responsible for accidents or injury.

1. Pool hours are from sunrise to 10:00 PM.
2. No diving. No running. No loud, or rough, or boisterous conduct allowed in pool area. No water balloons allowed. Children will be warned if not following rules.
3. Children not yet toilet trained must wear approved swim diapers or rubber pants.
4. No animals or pets allowed in the pool area.
5. No glass containers allowed in pool area.
6. No smoking allowed in the pool area.
7. BBQ grilling is not allowed in pool area or clubhouse covered porches.
8. Please dispose of all trash and take all personal items when leaving the pool area. Please fold up pizza boxes so they fit in the trashcans. Do not them on top of the trashcans.
9. All unclaimed items, (i.e. towels, goggles, floating devices) will be placed in a lost and found box. Lost and found box will be emptied weekly.
10. All parents are responsible for actions of children in bathrooms. Please accompany young children to the bathroom.
11. Please return all pool furniture to its proper place after use. Please turn off all bathhouse lights and fans after use.
12. Please shower before entering pool.
13. Please don't swim alone.
14. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
15. No person with skin, eye, ear or nasal infections or any other form of communicable disease is allowed in the pool.
16. No loud radios or sound equipment is allowed in the pool area.
17. Life rings, preservers, and Shepard hooks are for emergency use only.
18. Pool monitors will remove all unattended floating devices because they can clog skimmers and prevent them from working properly.
19. Do not remove or play with skimmer lids. If not properly put in place they can become a hazard to people walking around the pool deck.
20. Please park in designated parking areas and not on the clubhouse entrance circle. This includes golf carts.
